

Champagne

House Champagne Brut (France)	36.95
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The House of Cuperly dates back to 1845 and still today remains within the original family. The blend is made from 40% Chardonnay and 60% Pinot Noir and the wine has a golden tinge with a persistent froth. On the palate this Champagne has a delicious fresh fruit flavour with a richness and complexity typical of Pinot Noir.

Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial Non Vintage (France)	54.95
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Moët & Chandon's oenologists work to produce well-balanced assemblages combining the three champagne grape varieties, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay, and utilising the richness and diversity of the champagne 'terroir' to express their essence. Still the best selling Non-Vintage Champagne in the U.K.

Lanson Black Label Brut Non Vintage (France)	52.95
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With impressions of vitality and springtime scents, together with hints of 'toast' and from a variety of flowers honey. A bouquet of ripe fruits and citrus create a sensation of plenitude and lightness. Rounded and rich, the hints of honey and spice underlining the age and quality, which is outstanding. A blend of 35% Chardonnay, 50% Pinot Noir, 15% Pinot Meunier. Lanson only leaves the cellars once fully matured, a minimum of 3 years for the Black Label.

Laurent Perrier Rose Brut Cuvee Non Vintage (France)	75.95
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Laurent Perrier Rose stems from the very careful preservation of the grape's natural fresh red fruit aromas. It is one of the rare rosé champagnes to be made using the maceration technique, giving extraordinary depth and freshness that has made it the benchmark for rosé champagne around the world. Meticulous sorting of the grape bunches (100% Pinot Noir) and controlled maceration help extract the colour and reveal the full aromatic richness of the pinot noir grapes. Unlike most rosé champagnes, the basis of Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut is obtained by drawing the juice from black grapes in the vat, not only blending red and white wines. It is cellared for at least four years.

Dom Perignon Vintage (France)	170.00
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Dom Perignon Vintage Champagne one of the worlds most famous Champagnes, this prestige cuvée Com Perignon 2002 Vintage released in 2010 retains its founders modern vision of true luxury. The making of each vintage involves a delicate job of assemblage and adjustment, before the mysterious balance between Dom Perignon's chardonnay and pinot noir can be reached.

House Wine

Las Montanas Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)	17.95
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Fruity and refreshing with floral, citrus and green apple flavours balanced by a hint of ripe tropical fruit. 12.5%

Las Montanas Chardonnay (Chile)	17.95
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Smooth and satisfying with ripe peach and pineapple flavours and a hint of creamy richness.

Las Montanas Merlot (Chile)	17.95
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Las Montanas Merlot is soft and fruity with plenty of succulent berry and damson flavours, and a pleasing hint of cinnamon spice typical of this user-friendly grape variety. Serve at cool room temperature as it is, or enjoy with roast or grilled red meats, game and mature hard cheeses. 13.5%

Las Montanas Rose (Portugal)	17.95
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A light pink, refreshing and fruity rose bursting with aromas of strawberries, raspberries, peardrops and pineapples. Soft and fruity with a light sparkle on the palate.

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A good alternative for those who find other fizz too dry. A soft, fresh and grapey fizz with flower nose and a medium sweet, refreshing finish

White Wine

Chablis (France)	28.95
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Made in classic Chablis style, lean and elegant with underlying Chardonnay fruit. This highly popular wine is perfect for any fish dish.

Chablis Premier Cru (France)	35.95
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Cru has an undoubtedly classy nose with real depth of flavour. Smooth, harmonious and very much in balance, this is a multi-layered and soothing wine which will be best enjoyed from 2012 onwards.

Macon Villages (France)	24.50
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Produced in the Maconnais in southern Burgundy, this wine is well balanced and freshly on the palate. An aromatic wine sporting fruity flavours.

Sancerre Sauvignon Blanc (France)	28.95
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A wine of style marked by richness, elegance and smoothness. This wine is powerful and presents a perfect by balance.

Muscadet (France)	19.95
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Made from the Muscadet grape and a classic example from the region, this wine is crisp, clean and refreshingly dry, this traditional Loire which is delicious either on its own or as an accompaniment to seafood.

Rioja (Spain)	21.95
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Pale golden in colour with hints of honey & lemon on the nose, this white wine is crisp and well balanced to taste with mild citrus and apple with a delicately spiced finish.

Piersporter Michelsberg Schmitt (Germany)	17.95
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Produced from the steep slatey Vineyards in the Mosel, this wine is well balanced with complex grape aromas and a slightly lemyish finish.

Pinot Grigio (Italy)	19.95
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A popular dry white wine, clean, with good fruit and style that finishes well.

Frascati (Italy)	24.95
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Sourced from the hills surrounding Rome, this dry white wine has a fresh lemon and floral character with a soft rounded finish.

Blossom Hill White (USA)	17.95
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A crisp wine with apple and melon aromas and an elegant finish

San Andres Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)	19.95
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Appetizing, zippy, fresh white wine with hints of crushed nettles and green leaves. A good match with fish in batter, salads and chicken in a Cajun sauce.

Oxford Landing Chardonnay (Australia)	23.95
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Extended lees contact at the end of fermentation has given this wine an even creamier texture on the palate which is complemented by the fresh melon and peach flavours. The natural fruit drive of this wine is balanced by a lively natural acidity leading to a clean, fresh finish.

Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)	24.95
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A great Aussie that shows all the deliciously ripe tropical and citrus character that we love and expect.

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An appealing easy drinking medium dry style of wine, with a slight spritz and light fruit flavours.

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Red Wine

Beajolais (France)	27.95
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This wine comes from Gamay grapes and so can be drunk slightly chilled, in order to protect the delicious aromas of fruits and the delicate freshness of the wine. This Beaujolais Villages can be drunk young but will age well for 2-3 years. Ideal as an aperitif or with salads and light meats. The best wines exhibit a wonderful complexity of aromas and flavours, great elegance and refinement and an ability to age gracefully - some for a hundred years.

Chateaufort Du Pape (France)	33.95
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The warm climate and heat-retaining large rounded stones from this area, ripen the grapes to a high degree of maturity, thus producing a full bodied, spicy, robust wine with deep colour.

Cotes du Rhone (France)	20.95
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Warm spicy wine that has a soft peppery taste coming from the Grenache and Syrah varieties. This wine can be enjoyed when it is young but will also age well.

St Emilion (France)	27.95
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Deep red in colour, St Emilion is a blend of 95% Merlot, which gives spice, damson fruit and cassis aromas, plus 5% Cabernet Franc to give firm tannins and a touch of red berry flavour on the palate. Ageing in top quality French oak barrels has given complex, mellow, long finish without overpowering the juiciness of the Merlot Fruit.

Faustino VII Rioja (Spain)	23.50
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The colour of Autumn vine leaves with hints of oak on the nose, this classic red Rioja is soft and velvety and very easy to drink. This wine is aged for 5 months in oak casks then left to mature for a further 2 years in the bottle. To this extent it is often said that the significance of the Roman Numerals 'VII' in the name, the 'V' meaning 5 and the 'II' meaning 2.

Faustino I Gran Reserva (Spain)	38.95
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This is probably one of the most famous and recognised labels on the market today. A Spanish icon, first released in 1964 and one of the great traditionally styled Gran Reservas. Pale Victoria plum in colour, aromas of the plums and raspberries combined with hints of cedar, vanilla and spice. This is a smooth and velvety wine with excellent integration of Christmas Cake fruits and spices with a hint of vanilla on the finish. Its complexity and harmony results from the prolonged ageing with 30 months spent in a combination of French and American oak and at least 3 years in the bottle.

Campo Viejo Rioja (Spain)	21.95
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Spanish nise, with a consistent follow-through on the taste: earthy, with a hint of cherries. Mellow finish that doesn't overpower your palette leaves you wanting more.

Chianti (Italy)	24.95
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Easy drinking with ripe berry aromas & rich cherries flavours on the plate, stunning.

Barolo (Italy)	35.95
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Made in Piedmont from Nebbiolo grapes, Barolo is one fo Italy's most famous red wines - Enticing aromas of tobacco and spice, deep dried fruit flavours and a touch of oak make this gold medal winner a wonderful example. Soft and mellow with red berry fruit aromas and an easy finish.
